- **Conditions for recommendation** 
  - $\blacktriangleright$  Under 45 years of age
  - > At least one published scientific paper in the SCI(E) journal as the first author
  - One fully analyzed study that the candidate plans to publish
  - Presentation files with draft paper about the study


