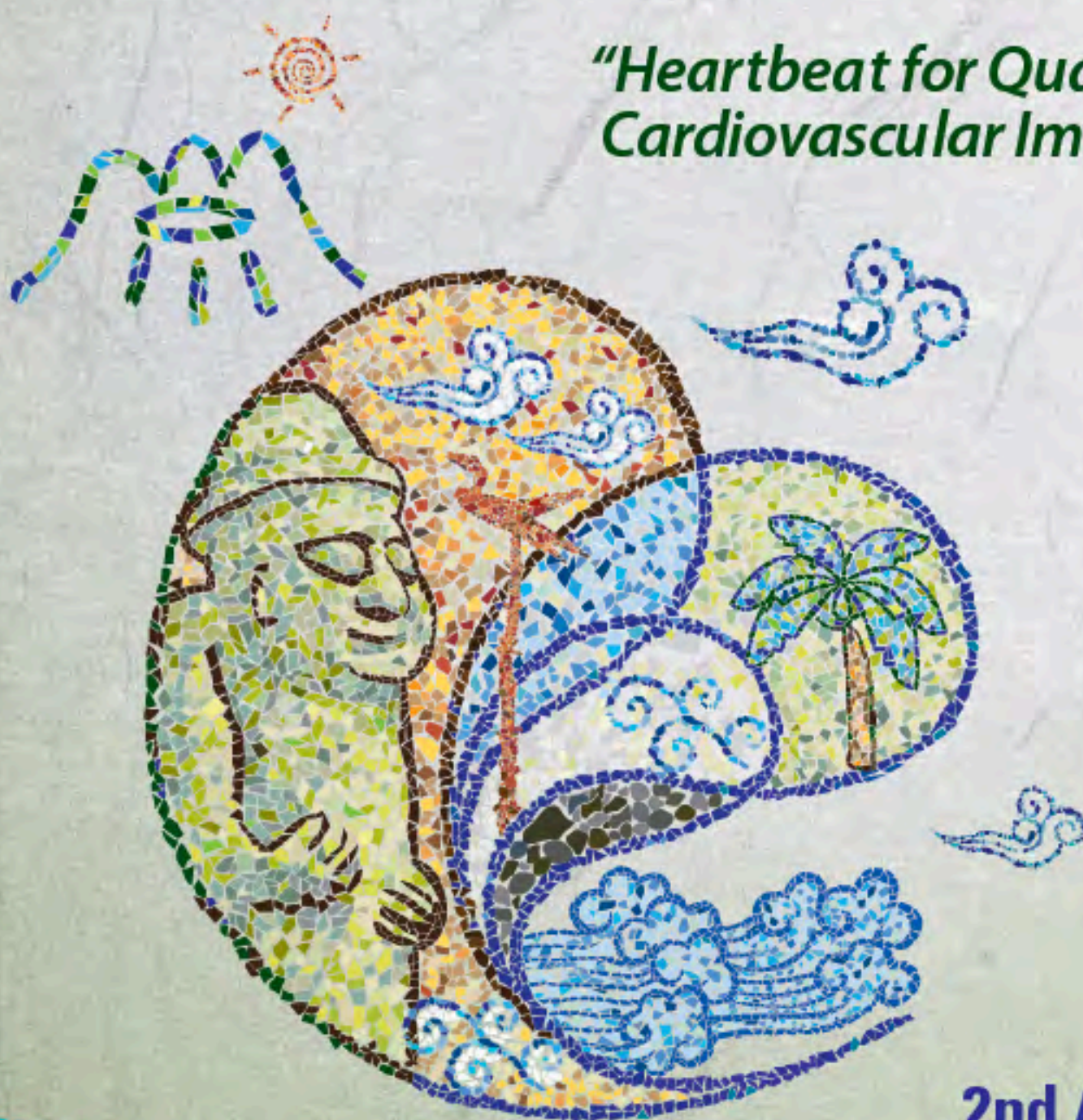



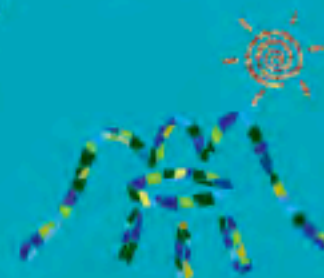

UNESCO Triple Crown

First place in the world to obtain UNESCO designations in all three natural sciences.

Jeju, which was created by volcanic activity, is known for its unique volcanic features; the entire island itself is like a volcanic museum. There are 368 *oreum* on the island and over 160 lava tubes are scattered on the island. It's very rare to see a small island that has both *oreum* and caves. The value of Jeju was proved as the island was designated Biosphere Reserve in 2002, World Natural Heritage in 2007, and Global Geopark in 2010, making the sub-tropical island the only place on Earth to receive all three UNESCO designations in natural sciences.

Jeju has now become a 'treasure island of environmental assets' that the world has to preserve.

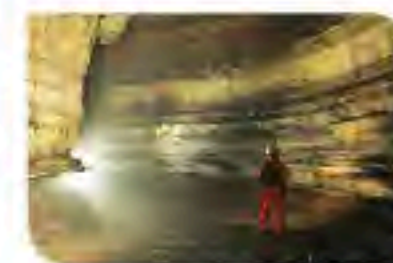

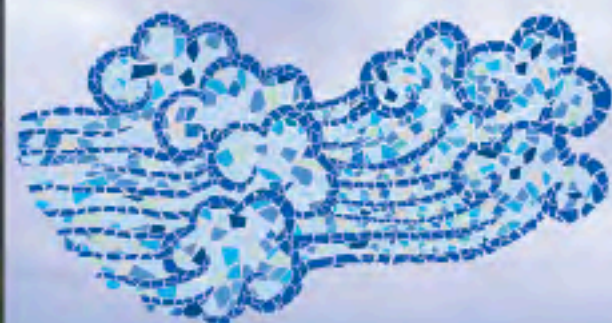

Access to Jeju

For international meetings, no-visa entry is possible upon arrival in Jeju through a connection at Incheon Airport.



Four ways to fly to Jeju Island:

- ① Direct international flight
- ② Transfer through Asian major hub airports where direct flights to Jeju Island are available
- ③ Transfer from Incheon International Airport (ICN) which is the gateway to the Republic of Korea
- ④ Transfer through Incheon International Airport, bus transfer to Gimpo Airport (GMP - the second airport of Seoul), and then to Jeju Island. Please make sure to arrange your travel until Jeju Island. The IATA code of Jeju International Airport is CJU.

1. From [Incheon International Airport](#), there are a few flights to Jeju Island with Korean Air and Asiana Airlines, with a flight time of approximately one hour. For flight schedules, please check the airline websites.
2. You can also [go to Gimpo International Airport](#) from Incheon International Airport easily. On arrival at Incheon International Airport, take an airport limousine bus or AREX (Airport Railroad Train) to Gimpo Airport. It takes about 30 minutes.

* Please note that in case you fly to Jeju via Gimpo Domestic Airport or visit other cities in Korea, a visa must be obtained prior to arrival in Korea. In this regard, please check the Korean Embassy in your country.

Airport Limousine Bus (from Incheon Int'l Airport to Gimpo Airport)



When you arrive in Korea, you can use Korea City Air Limousine at bus stand 3B or 10A and 4B or 11A for KAL Limousine (from Incheon International Airport to Gimpo International Airport) on the 1st floor outside Incheon International Airport Terminal. You may get information regarding the buses and purchase tickets at the Transportation Information Counter (near Exits No. 4, 9) on the arrival floor of the passenger terminal. Fare is approximately KRW 6,000 (≈USD 5).

AREX (Airport Railroad Train) (from Incheon Int'l Airport to Gimpo Airport)



Please take All Stop Train to get to Gimpo Airport. First train for Gimpo Airport is at 5:24 a.m. and the last train for Gimpo Airport is at 24:00 p.m. Fare is approximately KRW 5,000 (≈USD 4).

4 From Gimpo International Airport to Jeju International Airport

There are 50 to 70 flights everyday from Gimpo Airport to Jeju with Korean Air, Asiana Airlines, Jeju Air, and so on. Flight time is approximately 50 minutes. For flight schedules, please check the airline websites.

Travel from Incheon to Gimpo Airport takes about 30 minutes as mentioned above. However, you should plan 3 hours between your arrival time at Incheon International Airport and your departure time at Gimpo International Airport to allow for check in. Therefore, if you arrive at Incheon International Airport after 17:30, you may not be able to fly on the same day to Jeju Island and you should stay overnight in one of the hotels near Gimpo Airport.

The unit of the Korean currency is the Won (₩). Coin denominations are ₩10, ₩50, ₩100 and ₩500. Banknotes are ₩1,000, ₩5,000, ₩10,000 and ₩50,000. The exchange rate is approximately US\$1 to KRW ₩1,100.

Tax

Value-Added Tax (VAT) is levied on most goods and services at a standard rate of 10% and is included in the retail price. In tourist hotels, this 10% tax applies to rooms, meals and other services and is included in the bill.



Time Difference

Korean time is 9 hours ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT+9).



Tipping

Tipping is not customary in Korea. Sometimes, expensive restaurants and luxury hotels may add a service charge of 10%. Thus, you do not necessarily have to prepare for extra charges since it will be included in the bill.



Electricity

In Korea, 220 volt outlets are common. However, please check the power supply before use, because some hotels provide 110 volt outlets for the convenience of their customers.



Telephone Calls

For international calls, first dial the international dialing code (001, 002 or 008), then the country code, followed by the area code, and then the phone number. You can rent a cell phone at the airport.



Emergency Numbers

Dial 119 for the fire department and medical assistance and 112 for the police.
